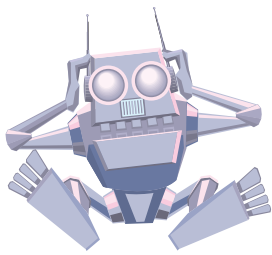


Grades 5-8

The program will challenge the girls to identify problems and come up with an original concept to solve that problem. Through hands-on activities under the supervision of female engineers, girls will learn first-hand what it would be like to work in the engineering field.
